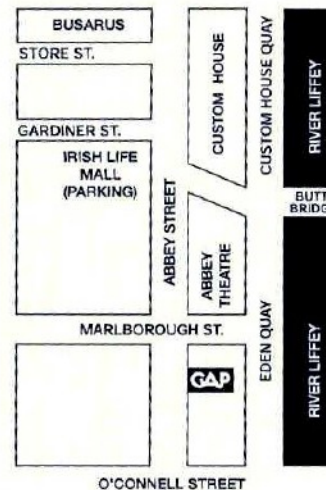

A Two-Day Workshop on Small Group Dynamics

- **Theory session-** Presentation of relevant psychodynamic theory
